Description: The University of South Carolina will award Palmetto Girls State Scholarships to two students in the incoming freshman class. These awards are worth \$1,500 per year and are renewable for three consecutive years. Students must maintain a cumulative 3.0 GPA per year and not miss a Fall or Spring semester. To be considered, students must be graduates of Palmetto Girls State, apply to the University by December 1, and be accepted. No separate scholarship application is required. Recipients will be notified by mail in March.

Qualifications: Palmetto Girls State graduates are considered based on high school grades and SAT or ACT scores.

Description: Presidential and Deans Scholarships will be awarded to Girls State participants who are interested in attending Voorhees College. The Presidential Scholarship will cover up to the cost of tuition, room and board. It does not include books. The Deans Scholarship will cover up to the cost of tuition. It does not include books.

Qualifications: Presidential Scholarship: High school cumulative grade point average 3.50-4.00; Rank in Top 20% of Graduating Senior Class or SAT 1000+ or ACT 21+. Students must meet two of three listed requirements. Deans Scholarship: High school cumulative GPA 3.00-3.49; Rank in Top 30% of Graduating Senior Class or SAT 900-990 or ACT 19+. Students must meet two of three listed requirements.

Description: The Palmetto Girls State Scholarship is awarded to at least one entering freshman each year. This award is worth \$80,000, is payable at \$20,000 per year, and is renewable for three years. All graduates of Palmetto Girls State who are accepted for admission will be considered.

Qualifications: Graduates of Palmetto Girls State are considered based on high school grades, courses, GPA, class rank, SAT/ACT scores, activities, and recommendations.

NOTE: Palmetto Girls State does not provide college scholarships to girls who have attended and completed the program. However, a number of colleges and universities within South Carolina recognize the outstanding abilities of the girls who attend Palmetto Girls State and provide some scholarship opportunities to girls who have attended and completed the Palmetto Girls State program. We at Palmetto Girls State appreciate that South Carolina's institutions of higher education are willing to recognize outstanding individuals who have attended and completed the program at Palmetto Girls State. However, please be aware that Palmetto Girls State neither offers these scholarships nor selects the recipients. The colleges and universities offering these scholarships set forth the criteria for the scholarships, and those institutions are then responsible for selecting the recipients. Palmetto Girls State does, upon request, make available to colleges and universities the roster of girls (1) who attended and completed the program and (2) who granted permission for their names to be included in the roster distributed to outside entities. Further, Palmetto Girls State works with representatives of Palmetto Boys State in providing this list of potential scholarship opportunities. However, neither Palmetto Girls State nor Palmetto Boys State make any representation or guarantee that these scholarships are available every year or that these scholarships will in fact be awarded. The offering of any scholarship and the award of a scholarship rests completely with the individual college or university.
